Assumption of Risk

Club Expectations

1. RESPECT all mentors, group leaders, volunteers, other club members, the building, everything in the building, and every place we visit.

2. Stay behind the LINES and out of CUPBOARDS unless you have permission from your mentor/ group leader.
3. You must STAY seated during meal times. Ask your mentor any questions.
4. STAY in your assigned academic or activity group at all times. Direct your questions to your mentor/group leader.
5. Once you are inside and signed in, you must NOT leave the building without permission from staff or without a parent/guardian.
6. Keep all LEGS on the floor - chair legs and your own. Do not lean back and do not stand on the chairs.
7. NO GUM, SNACKS or DRINKS other than water allowed during club time or on the vans. Anything other than water will be asked to be thrown away.
8. All BACKPACKS and bags need to be put up in its designated area. Ask your mentor/group leader for permission to get into your bag.
9. Please do NOT bring money, phones or other electronics to the club, if you do it is at your own risk. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
10. You will COMPLETE your work at academic time, if you do not you will complete it during activity time.
11. You are required to FINISH what you START! No QUITTING, walking away and POUTING, or whining during games, sports, or activities.
12. Do not RUN indoors. We have the gym and outdoors for running.
13. There should be no more than ONE person in the bathroom at a time. Child must be old enough to use the bathroom by themselves.
14. PLEASE do not ask what group you are in or if you can do a particular activity. If you are able to choose we will ask you.

SAFETY PROCEDURES & EXPECTATIONS

We are very excited to see youth back in the Clubs! We have taken steps to reopen, in a limited way, while following guidelines to keep everyone safe.

What will be done to keep everyone safe?

Before youth (and staff!) can get on the van or enter the Club, the following will happen:

- Temperature check (if over 99.6 degrees, cannot come to Club for 1 week)
- Health Questionnaire
- Hand cleansing

During the Club day, the following will happen

- Staff will wear masks whenever working with youth.
- Groups will never contain more than ten individuals (staggered schedule).
- The building will be thoroughly sanitized before Club and between groups. The van will be cleaned between rides.
- Social distancing will happen in various ways, including modified feeding set up.

What do parents need to do?

1. If your child is sick, please keep them home.

Sickness includes any of these symptoms:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches.
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

2. If your child has been exposed to someone who tested positive for COVID-19, or if someone in the home is sick (see above), please keep them home at least until that person has recovered.
3. Drop-off, Pick-up, and discussions need to happen outside in the fresh air. Please understand that we must minimize the number of people in the building.
4. Let us know if your child has any special needs or if anything has changed since we last served them. We know this has been a stressful time for all.

Thank you for your understanding. We know that some guidelines can be hard to follow, and we understand that we will not be able to serve every youth every day, as we strive to keep everyone safe. We have appreciated the support of our communities as we served from a distance, and look forward to working with you moving forward.

On The T.R.A.I.L. (Together Raising Awareness for Indian Life) To Diabetes Prevention

Caretaker (Parent/Guardian) Notice Form

Your child has been invited to participate in the On the T.R.A.I.L. (Together Raising Awareness for Indian Life) to Diabetes Prevention program. This program is designed to provide youth with the tools and knowledge to prevent type 2 diabetes through healthy eating and physical activity. T.R.A.I.L. is the first diabetes prevention program developed for Boys & Girls Clubs on Native lands.

This program will:

- Discuss health topics in a way your child can understand.
- Encourage healthy behaviors that will help your child stay healthy, active, and prevent type 2 diabetes.

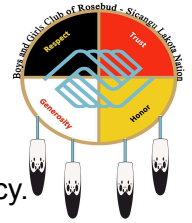
As part of the program the Club will administer a pre- and post-test to test your child's knowledge and attitude about nutrition, physical activity, and type 2 diabetes. Basic information will also be collected about your child and shared with the Indian Health Service (IHS), National Congress of American Indians (NCAI), and FirstPic, Inc. Your child's name will not be used and personal information will be kept confidential.

As part of the physical activity portion of the T.R.A.I.L. program, your child is invited to participate in Physical Activity Challenges. The challenges will measure strength and endurance periodically throughout the program. Strength will be measured through the plank and push-ups and endurance will be measured through the shuttle run. Data collected from these challenges will also be shared with the IHS, NCAI, and FirstPic, Inc. Your child's name and personal information will be kept confidential. **Children with medical conditions that prevent strenuous activity such as jumping and/or running should not participate.**

Respect Policy:

Respect, or Wa o' hola, is the all-encompassing #1 rule of the Boys and Girls Club of Rosebud, applicable to staff, club members, volunteers, and board members. Respect includes respect of self, surroundings, others, materials, and time.

"Treat people and things like they should be treated"



Discipline Policy for Club Members:

Minor and Major offenses are actions that do not follow our aforementioned Respect policy.

Minor Offense: Logical Consequences will be appropriately assigned to the club member by staff appropriate to the offense (i.e. if you make a mess, you clean it up) in accordance to our #1 rule.

Major Offense: Incident Report created by staff and a phone call will be made to the guardians to discuss the incident and specific actions taken as well as a plan for the future. The phone call must be placed before the end of the work day of the incident. The Incident Report must be written, signed, and filed 24 hours after the incident. A copy of the incident report may be requested by the club member's guardians.

Actions in regards to a first-time major offense may include but is not limited to; requesting immediate pickup or drop-off, "In-house" suspension (working on special assigned tasks during club time), suspension from club ranging anywhere from one day to permanent expulsion, loss of privileges within the club (with a plan to gain them back), or sending assignments home, depending on the nature and severity of the offense.

Second Major Offense OR Expulsion; In addition to the aforementioned actions (or in the case of first offense leading to expulsion), a phone call with the site director, any relevant staff and parents/guardians will be made to address issues and discuss a resolution.

*In cases where contact with guardians cannot be made with reasonable effort, full time staff will create and document a resolution and send a copy home with the club member, including any actions taken.

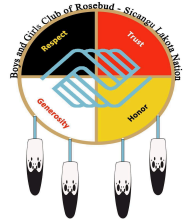
What We Need From You

In-house Policies: What We Do to Ensure Your Member's Safety

The BGCR staff and volunteers also follow numerous best practices regarding youth safety during Club time and all trips. They are listed below.

- Annual comprehensive background checks on all staff and volunteers.
- First Aid and CPR certification training is provided annually.
- All staff receive child safety and youth development training, both national and local.
- Over 30 security cameras are present throughout the Clubs and always recording.
- Volunteers are always paired with trained Club staff, never alone.
- Annual, external, health and safety inspections of each Club building by IHS.
- Certified lifeguards must be present for all swimming activities.
- Seat belts are required at all times in Club vehicles.

- Zero-tolerance of harassment or misconduct
- Mandatory reporters of any obvious or suspected abuse towards members, volunteers, or employees
- Confidentiality policy towards all non-public BGCR information
